


The Willison Family - Hamilton

When our four-year-old daughter Fleur was diagnosed with acute lymphoblastic leukaemia last year, our world was turned upside down. Overnight, we were thrown into a new life of hospital wards, blood tests, and chemotherapy.

Fleur has faced far more than any four-year-old should, countless rounds of chemotherapy, blood transfusions, spinal taps, and general anaesthetics. Yet she continues to giggle, play, and be brave, showing a strength and spirit that leave us in awe every single day.

In the middle of all this, Ronald McDonald House became our home away from home. Because of it, our family could stay together while Fleur was in Starship Hospital. I was able to be by her side in hospital, while her dad, Jackson, stayed close at the House each night. Even Fleur's big brother, Greyson, who was just six, could visit. It wasn't easy on him either, but being able to see his sister and spend time together brought a little piece of normal life into such a hard time for us all.

Ronald McDonald House took away the worries of where we would stay, how we would eat, or how we could stay close to Fleur. Instead, we could focus on what mattered most, supporting her through treatment. It wasn't just a roof over our heads - it was community, kindness, and care right when we needed it most. Even now, as Fleur continues her treatment at



Starship, we still rely on the support of Ronald McDonald House to help us stay together and navigate the challenges of her treatment.


The Bourton Family - Hamilton
